NAMI KIM



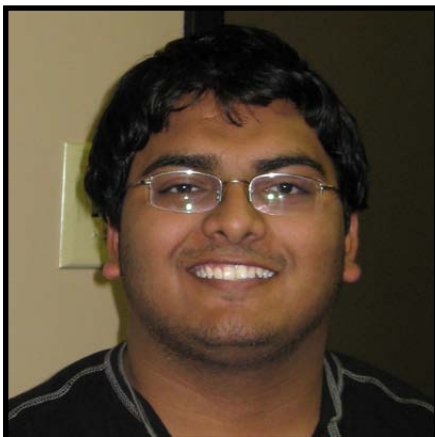

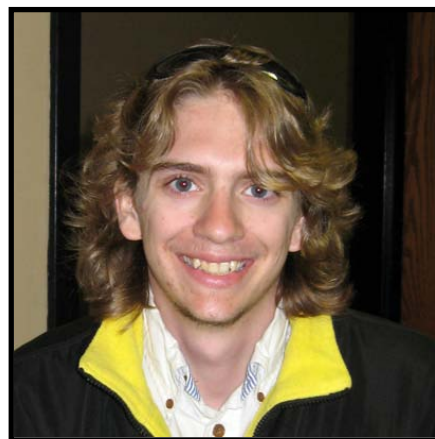


MEGHAL SHAH

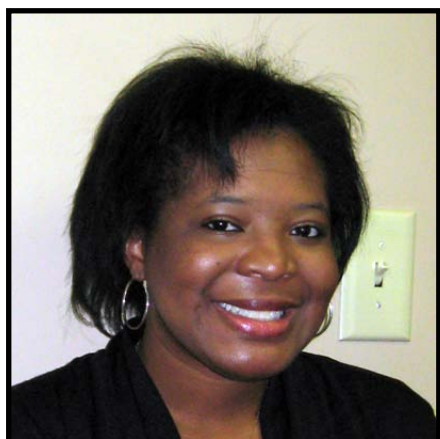


LEI JIANG

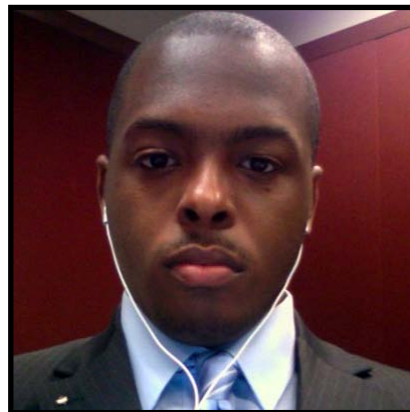
KAREN BOOMER
