In your letter of application, please address the following topics:

1. What interests you about the Faculty-in-Residence program?
2. Have you lived on campus as a faculty member or administrator? If so, please describe these experiences.
3. What non-teaching activities or interactions have you had with students (e.g., study abroad, residence hall program, dinners)?
4. What special skills, qualities, or experiences would you bring to the Faculty-in-Residence program?
5. A Faculty-in-Residence traditionally offers programs around an interdisciplinary theme. For example, Dr. Susan Bauer-Wu sponsors programs on "Resilience" while Dr. Irene Browne offers programs on "Sex and Sexuality."
