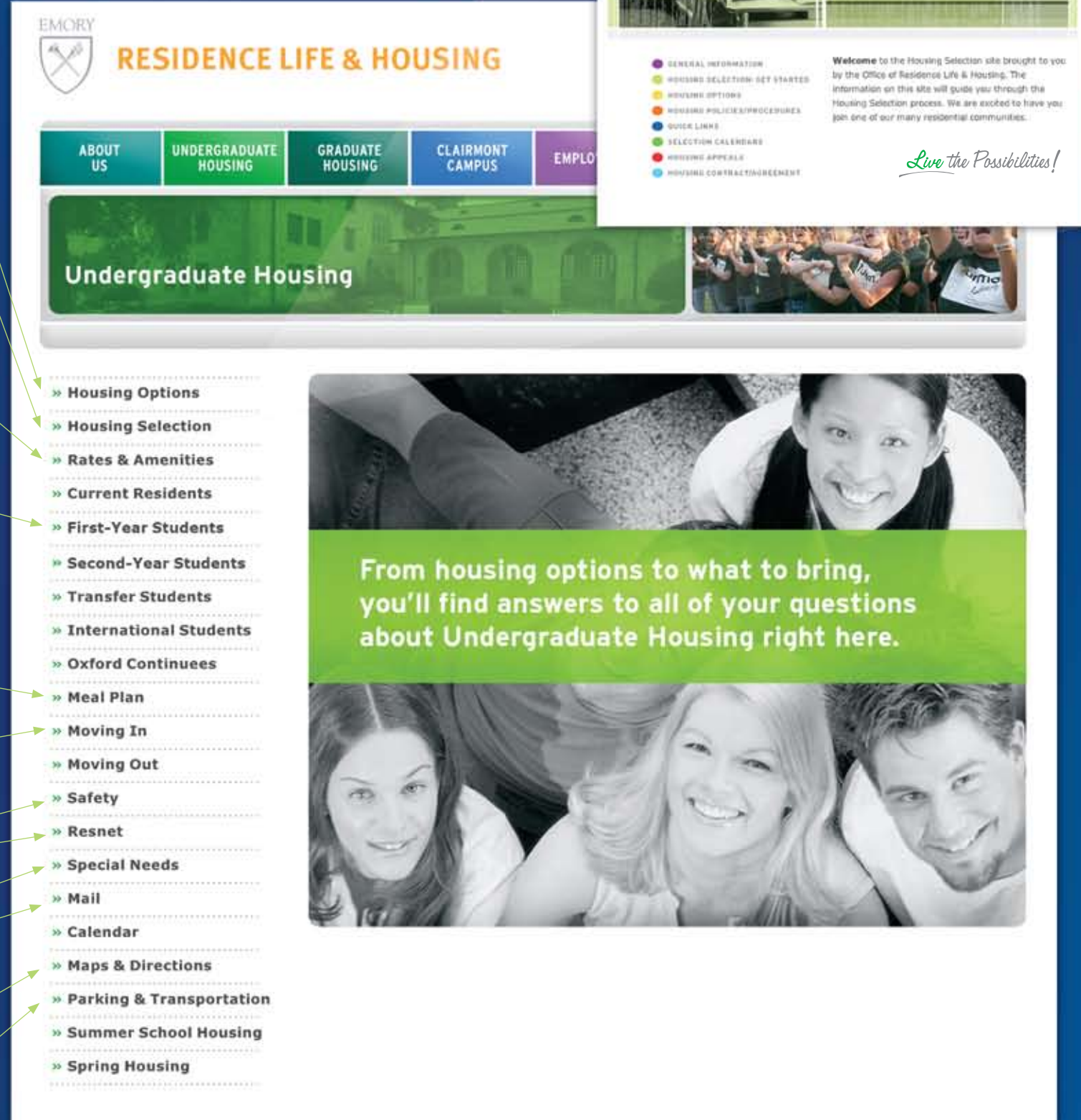

FIRST-YEAR STUDENT INFORMATION

"First-year student" is the term used at Emory to designate a student that is participating in his or her first year of study at the University. Typically, a first-year student has a freshman class standing; but regardless of the number of academic credit hours, students in their first year of study will remain "first-year" students.

FIRST-YEAR AT EMORY

The first-year experience as a resident in on-campus housing is unique and exciting. All first-year and second-year students are required to live on campus, which creates strong communities in our residence halls. Each of Emory's residence halls offers students a different flavor of college life, one that develops according to the needs and personalities of the residents.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

In order to live on campus, first-year students must apply for housing through our online housing selection process. First-year students may select the type of room and hall in which they wish to live, but may not request a specific building. Assignments are made based on preferences indicated on the application, and are available in early June.

Before you begin the housing application process, you should:

- Familiarize yourself with the housing options
- Familiarize yourself with the meal plans
- Read the Housing Agreement
- Review the housing selection information for "First-Year Students" located at www.emory.edu/HOUSING/SELECTION

The Undergraduate Housing Agreement is a one-year contract. Your online signature of the Undergraduate Housing Agreement is binding and acknowledges your obligation to follow the policies and procedures of the University.

Once you are ready to begin the housing selection process, log on to www.emory.edu/HOUSING and click **APPLY FOR UNDERGRADUATE HOUSING**. The log-in screen will prompt you to enter your Network ID.

2009-2010 RESIDENCE HALL CALENDAR

Emory's residence halls are open throughout the semesters, including holidays. The only times our residence halls close are during the winter break and at the end of the academic year.

August 22 - Residence halls open for first-year and new upperclass students

December 17 - Residence halls close for fall semester; residents must vacate by noon

January 10 - Residence halls open for spring semester

May 11 - Residence halls close for the summer; residents must vacate within 24 hours of last final
