Welcome to the Living Green community and to Emory! We are excited to have you join our family. As move in day quickly approaches, please keep in mind the following information.

Check-in will occur on Saturday, August 22 from 7:30am to 2:00pm in the Few Lobby. There will be plenty of people and signs to show you the way. This year, check-in will be staggered. We will be sending you an email with your assigned check-in time in mid-July. Please try to arrive as close to your assigned check-in time as possible. If you arrive in Atlanta early, enjoy your morning with a great breakfast in the area or take a tour of Decatur, then head to campus! Please make sure you bring a picture ID in order to begin the check-in process. Our staff will be giving you a lot of materials when you check-in. Take the time to read over them.

During move-in, traffic may be re-routed, and streets may convert to one-way traffic to allow for easier access to our halls. The Emory Police Department and Emory Parking Services will be assisting with traffic movement that day, so please help them by closely following directions provided. We will have volunteers to assist you with unloading your car and carrying your belongings to your room!

You will be allowed to park in front of Few and Evans residence halls to unload your car. Once you have unloaded your belongings, we will ask you to move your car to one of our designated parking decks. Be sure to not leave your car unattended, park in a fire lane or specially marked parking space as you may be ticketed or towed. Shuttles will be running back and forth from the decks, so there is no a need to worry about walking in the hot sun or getting lost on campus.

Your first mandatory hall meeting will be that Saturday evening after your Orientation activities. The exact time will be posted on your hall. This is a wonderful time to meet your Resident Advisors, Sophomore Advisors, and your new hall-mates.

We will provide you with a map of our area to better understand the traffic flow for your move-in as it becomes available. Please become familiar with this map and keep it handy as you head to Emory.
