The Carter Center Liaison Committee is a standing committee of the University Faculty Council. The Chair is the immediate Past Chair of the Council. Other members include the Carter Center's Director of Educational Programs and the Vice-Provost for International Affairs.

## **Goals**

The Committee's charge is to administer the faculty liaison program in which Emory University faculty work with the Carter Center programs for a period of a year. Specifically, the Committee:

- \* recruits faculty liaisons through a process of advertisement, distribution of applications, evaluation of applications, consultation with faculty deans to ensure administrative support for liaisons;
- \* consults with liaisons presently involved in Carter Center programs;
- \* coordinates meeting of liaisons to review and prepare report to the Faculty Council:
  - o liaisons meet with the Committee in March;
  - o Committee Chair reports to the Faculty Council at its final meeting in April.
