Goals:

1. To support scholarly research in all disciplines throughout the university by providing intramural grants up to \$30,000.
2. To provide expert peer-review of all applications and give detailed feedback to each applicant, regardless of whether or not their proposal is funded by the URC.
3. To work with the new Center for Faculty Development and Excellence to assist Emory faculty with research career development including workshops on writing grant proposals that are being organized by the CFDE and its director, Laurie Patton.
4. To continue the tradition of the Levy Awards, which are provided annually to one junior faculty member and one senior faculty member based on their publication of an outstanding scientific manuscript in the past year. The awards are chosen by a panel of URC reviewers and are made thanks to an endowment from the Albert Levy family.
