Mission Statement

The Library Policy Committee works with the Director of Libraries/Vice Provost to enhance the quality, utility, and accessibility of the Libraries for the entire Emory community. It advises the Senate and the Director on significant policy issues, acts as a major channel of communication between users and the General Libraries, and may assist in communicating library concerns to the university administration. Issues of interest include:

- * Budget allocations from the university
- * Functioning of the University infrastructure for providing access to electronic information; remote access issues
- * Electronic publishing initiatives as they affect library acquisitions and collection development
- * Space distribution and utilization in the libraries
- * Policy issues such as the effect of intellectual property rights considerations on the operation of the Library
- * Policies governing access to electronic information
- * Use of professional school library resources by the Emory community
- * Operating policies such as hours, security plans, and access and borrowing privileges
