Goals:

The Campus Development Committee advises the University Senate and the Administration on all developments affecting the appearance and function of the Emory University campuses.

This committee reviews all renovations and capital projects as they are developed, from early in the planning stages through design and construction. We seek to understand, evaluate and communicate the impact on the entire Emory community. The committee reviews the design and site selection for new buildings and structures as well as the plans for remodeling existing buildings. In general it sees all plans that would affect the appearance or functioning of the built

campus environment. This includes the adequacy of campus lighting and the accessibility of campus structures to persons with special needs.

Our membership is drawn from faculty, staff, students and administrators; every effort is made to make the membership a microcosm of our diverse university community.

The Campus Development Committee works closely with the Committee on the Environment and the Committee on Traffic and Parking through liaison membership. These committees often consider the same proposed projects but emphasize different or complementary perspectives.

Plan: (1) In conjunction with the Center for Faculty Development and Excellence, the LPC has scheduled meetings this Fall with 7 of the 9 Schools, all 9 intended, to discuss Open Access initiatives and policies at Emory. Two meetings have already occurred. (2) Revisit all the Schools in the early Spring with a more concrete Resolution and plans for a Repository. (3) Present a consensus plan and resolution to the Faculty Senate late Spring for their consideration
