- (1) The Emory Pre-College Program credit courses earn 4 credit hours each. Students in this program have the option of enrolling in one course or two. Tuition rates are equivalent to the Emory College Programs summer hourly rate.
- (2) The Emory Pre-College Program non-credit courses' tuition represent FY2008-09 amounts. FY2009-10 tuition rates are subject to change upon further review of market conditions within these programs.
- (3) New students begin this program in the summer term. Entering students beginning this program in summer, 2010 will be charged a \$21,200 semester rate.
- (4) Students enrolled in the Evening MBA Program are charged a credit hour rate based on the number of enrolled hours. Students enrolled for a standard full-time load (6 credit hours per semester, 18 credit hours per year) will pay the equivalent of the approved annual tuition rate of \$23,400.
- (5) New students begin this program in the spring term. Entering students beginning this program in spring, 2010 will be charged a \$23,500 semester rate.
- (6) New students begin this program in the fall term. Entering students beginning this program in fall, 2009 will be charged a \$16,100 semester rate.
- (7) Students may choose to participate in between four and six credit hours of coursework. Tuition for the first four hours of instruction is \$3,700. The fee for each additional credit hour is \$750.
- (8) Students enrolled in this program are charged tuition and University and School of Medicine mandatory fees only during the fall and spring semesters, even if they enroll in the summer semester. Students in this program are not assessed any charges in summer semesters.
- (9) Medical students have the option to enroll for an additional year beyond the standard 4 year enrollment, but will not be assessed tuition for that year. However, University and School of Medicine mandatory fees still apply for the fall and spring semesters.
- (10) Students are charged a credit hour rate based on the number of enrolled hours.
- (11) All students in the traditional or accelerated program plans are responsible for the total tuition of their program (semesters x semester rate). Students in the traditional or accelerated program plans who register for less than 9 credit hours will be charged the full semester rate of their appropriate degree program plan. During summer semesters, the hourly rate applies when students take additional coursework above and beyond the 3 or 4 semester program plans and enroll in 8 credit hours or less.
- (12) The Career Masters of Public Health is a (part-time) distance learning program for which conversion of hourly course rates to a semester or annual rate is not applicable.
- (13) Students enrolled in 8 credit hours or less will be charged at the per credit hour rate. Students enrolled in 9 credit hours or more will shift to the Traditional Program full-time charge.

Notes:

- (1) The School of Medicine no longer collects application fees for visiting United States and Canadian medical students. However, the school uses the VSAS (Visiting Student Application Service) centralized application service that charges a fee for these prospective students.
- (2) The Rollins School of Public Health no longer collects application fees. However, the school requires students to apply through a centralized application service that charges prospective students a \$95 fee.
- (3) The Emory Pre-College Program Fee presented is for room and board and represent FY2008-09 amounts. FY2009-10 fees are subject to change upon further review of market conditions within these programs. Additional fees may apply.
- (4) The Emory Pre-College Program Fee for credit courses is applicable only for the second session. There is no residential program available for the first session.
- (5) Clinical Administrative Fee - Graduate Allied Health Programs is changing from a one-time fee of \$100 to a per semester fee of \$25.
- (6) Technology Fee - Medicine was previously assessed to third and fourth year medical students only, but will be assessed to all Medical students beginning in FY2009-10.
